Carbon Pilot Process

Made Simple



1. Collaborate

Collaborate with Bayer on the Carbon Pilot program and we will support you throughout the journey of transitioning to sustainable farming practices. Bayer will provide you with agronomic and technical support and reward you financially for implementing cover crops and strip-till or no-till practices on your eligible acres.



2. Execute

Transition your eligible acres to cover crops and strip/no-till. If desired, the Bayer field agronomy team can help you with cover crop selection that is best for your operation, but you can use the seed and brand of choice. Bayer will validate your acres using third-party partners, like Dagan technology, through automated remote sensing specific to conservation ag practices – there are no costs or operational requirements from you. You can focus on farming and we do the rest.



3. Collect


